The Westchester County Historical Society is pleased to call for nominations for the 2018 Sy Schulman History Award. The award was inaugurated in 2014 to honor the life and work of WCHS trustee Sy Schulman, who died in 2012. Schulman had a significant role in shaping the county we know today as the county's chief planner and planning commissioner in the 1960s. Throughout his life he championed the cause of preserving and promoting the history of the county. The award is given annually to an individual or organization that has demonstrated a strong commitment to historical research, historic preservation, and/or the teaching of local history, and has, as a result, elevated the public's appreciation of the history of Westchester County.

The 2018 award will be given at the WCHS Annual Meeting in June. The awardee will be chosen by a committee of the WCHS board of trustees from a list of nominees submitted by the public.
